Newly-refinished (2013) original hardwood floors

Living room (20'  $\times$  10') with crown molding, wood burning fireplace, and wall of builtins

First floor den/ office/ playroom (13'7" x 9'5") with ceiling fan, built-in shelving, double pane windows, and updated slate roof

Dining room (12'4" x 11'6") with chair rail, crown molding, ceiling fan, and double sliding doors to deck

Updated/ remodeled kitchen with contemporary open floor plan featuring granite counters, ample storage (including pantry closet), directional track lighting, and newer appliances: 4-burner gas Thermador stove, GE refrigerator with icemaker, Kenmore dishwasher, and garbage disposal. Updated second floor bathroom with shower and heat lamp plus lower level bathroom with bath tub
